

Carolina Türk Evi *Turkish House*



Türk Evi is owned by the Aziz & Gwen Sancar Foundation and is a Turkish Cultural Center with Private Rooms for Rent to Turkish Students and to Students Desiring Exposure to Turkish Culture

- Located at 743 East Franklin Street, Türk Evi is ONLY A 15 MINUTE WALK from the UNC-CH campus.
- There is a bus stop in front of the house for buses to Carrboro, the Medical school and Business School, as well as grocery and pharmacy. Bus service is free in Chapel Hill.
- Three one bedroom apartments, each with an attached private bath, are available upstairs. Downstairs an additional room with private bath or 2-room suite is available. Most of the rooms are much larger than those found in dorms and apartment complexes.
- **AMENITIES:**
 - ◆ The rooms have CENTRAL HEAT & AIR CONDITIONING.
 - ◆ Each bedroom is FURNISHED with a bed and a dresser or chest of drawers.
 - ◆ In addition to the PRIVATE CLOSET available in each bedroom, ADDITIONAL STORAGE SPACE IS AVAILABLE in the house proper, and in the finished dry basement.
 - ◆ A HUGE, FULLY EQUIPPED KITCHEN (6 burner stove, oven, freezer, refrigerator, dishwasher, dining area, dishes, glassware, cookware), FURNISHED TV room, large SCREENED-IN PORCH, beautiful shaded back yard with fig and peach trees, and FREE off-street parking.
 - ◆ WASHER AND DRYER provided FREE of charge on site.
 - ◆ Rent \$525 per month for one bedroom apartments, suite negotiable. THIS RENT INCLUDES WATER, NATURAL GAS, ELECTRICITY, TV AND HIGH SPEED INTERNET ACCESS.
